My name is Jeff Somers and I am the newly appointed Chairman of the Board following the resignation of Vivian Gonsalves.


We certainly live in challenging times. COVID-19, and its impact on Victoria, has created a whole new world for the way

we live now and possibly in the future. Our bank staff members have responded to the challenges thrown up by this pandemic in a fantastic way. Ensuring the bank building is safe for customers to enter is a high priority, regular cleaning of contact services is conducted during the day. Sanitiser is available for all customers and screens separating staff and customers have been installed at the branch. The Board has also developed a COVID-19 response plan.

So far on this COVID-19 journey we have no incidents of infection in staff or customers. However, it is worth knowing that the bank premises would be closed for deep cleaning if a staff member became infected or a recent customer showed a positive test result. In a worst case scenario, it may be necessary to close the bank for an extended period of time if all staff were in isolation. Customers will be able to contact the bank by phone in the unlikely event this situation arises. At this point in time cash delivery services are unaffected but, as the Wantirna ATM is loaded by branch staff, it would end up out of service as the building would be shut. In this unlikely situation the nearest Bendigo Banks are located in Ringwood, Bayswater and Boronia. There are also ATMs elsewhere in the Wantirna Mall.

The most noticeable change has been the decision by customers to embrace online banking. Our staff team have spent many hours walking through the process with customers

so that they can fully understand and use the online platform available for Bendigo Bank customers. Despite this trend, the Board is committed to maintaining



We have continued to financially support events and organisations within our community but to a lesser extent than previous years. The full impact of COVID-19 is now emerging and the Board has prudently held back on distributions to the community to ensure a healthy Balance Sheet is available to traverse the rocky and unknown waters ahead.
