

CLUB INFORMATION SHEET

Introduction

The competition has been running for 7 seasons and continues to grow from strength to strength. 82 registered teams in 2021.

The Competition

- Netball is played on Friday nights
- In line with the Football Season (April to end of August)
- 16/17 -week home and away season (19/20 weeks incl finals series)
- Finals format top 4, 3 week final
- 3 or 4 time slots a night (depending on venue), with games scheduled from 6:45pm onwards
- Players must be turning 15 during the season to be registered to play

Venues

The competition is played out of centralised venues located across the region. In season 2022, the indoor venues used will be:

- Fairhills High School, Knoxfield
- Oxley Stadium, Old Melbourne Road Chirnside Park
- Jells Park, Ferntree Gully
- HE Parker, Heathmont
- State Basketball Centre, Wantirna South

Registration and Fees

Registration is in two parts:

- 1. GameDay player registration
- 2. Netball Connect Netball Victoria Membership registration and payment

Both forms must be completed to be eligible to play for your club. All players must have a current Netball Victoria Membership to take the court. Please note payment for this is required on the Netball Connect Registration Form. If you have already paid to another Netball Association for 2022 you will not be charged again

Clubs are required to pay a registration fee for each team submitted to the competition. This fee assists to cover the operational costs of the competition such as court hire and umpires.

2022 Registration fee - \$1800.00 per team

*There are no weekly court fees or entry fees at each venue.

Netball Victoria Membership

EFNL is an affiliated league of Netball Victoria, therefore ALL players are required to have a Netball Victoria Membership to take part in the competition

2022 Netball Victoria membership fees are as below:

Senior \$80.00

(players, umpires, coaches and bench officials born on or before 31/12/2004 - 18 years and over)

Junior \$60.00

(players, umpires, coaches and bench officials born between 1/1/2005 - 31/12/2011 - 11-17 years)

Off the Court \$48.00

(committee members, administrators, volunteers, parents and spectators)

Insurance

Players are covered by insurance through their Netball Victoria Membership. Any injury claims need to be made through Netball Victoria.

Umpires

Umpires are provided by the league. The leagues umpire manager, Raechel Richards, is responsible for umpire development and allocations.

We are always looking to expand our umpire pool so if you or anyone you know is interested in umpiring, please contact the league.

Uniform

In accordance with the competitions' rules and regulations, all players must be in the same uniform to take the court.

For clubs entering teams into the competition for the first time, official uniform is not compulsory. Players may wear matching coloured skirts/shorts and tops in club colours or just black for example.

For clubs who have been in the competition for more than one year official uniform is required. Uniforms must be ordered through the leagues licensed suppliers – Gilbert Netball, On Track Sportswear (Champion), ESP (Puma) or Sherwood and must feature the EFNL logo.

Uniforms can include sponsors logo in accordance with the guidelines set out in the leagues By Laws. All uniform designs must be submitted to the Netball Manager and approved by the League prior to manufacture.
